3. Arrive every morning at the Camp Location (Lawrenceville Presbyterian Church, 2688 Main St, Lawrenceville, NJ) starting July 6th through August 21st, by 8:15 am until 3:15pm to tutor the children and/or after care hours.

As you can see, these are all important components of our overall goal. With a serious commitment from everyone, we will easily accomplish what we set out to do. Parental volunteerism is also encouraged and needed!

Title of Position: Youth Education Volunteer for grades K through 7

Purpose of Position: To encourage and support students in a summer enrichment program for math reading and writing and to serve as a mentor to assist with their academic work.

Time Commitment: Volunteers should commit to working with students 8:15am to 3:15pm, Monday through Friday. From **July 6, 2020 through August 21, 2020 (5 days, 30 hours a week). We will also need staggered shifts to help with Aftercare.**

QUALIFICATIONS: Sensitive and adaptable to learner's differences and needs. Accepting of people from different cultures, backgrounds and ages while Commitment to bettering lives through education, Patience and enthusiasm. (No previous teaching experience necessary.)

COMMITMENT: Attend training and orientation programs. Participate in Approx. 10 hours of tutoring per week. Attend follow-up workshops and tutor meetings as required. Agree to volunteer for at least 4 weeks (substitutes may be available when you must be absent.) The schedule can be flexible for tutors only but all time off must be pre scheduled.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

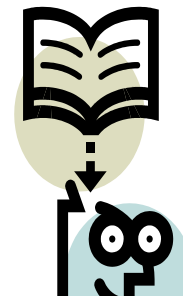
- Participate in initial training and volunteer in service opportunities to upgrade skills.
- Attend tutoring sessions as scheduled. If an absence is anticipated, call in advance so we may provide a substitute.
- Assist student through the learning process as defined by the program guidelines.
- Assign materials and advance levels when appropriate.
- Sign in and out to record time of service daily.
- Develop positive appropriate relationships with students.
- Maintain student records and take attendance.
- Observe confidentiality at all times.
- Keep staff informed about tutoring experience, job assignments, or any concerns you may have regarding the program.
